③ I'm fed up with all the housework. I'm the one who cleans all the house every week and cleans the dishes after every meal. Nobody helps me at all.

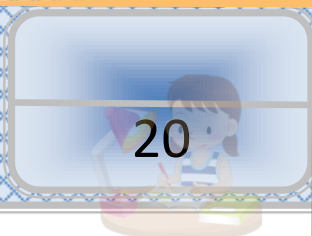
④ She controls all the money. I mean she took my credit card and everything, and doesn't even give me any pocket money. I just want to get out of the house. I even think about killing myself.

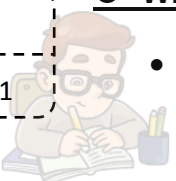
